3.a. Discuss and consider approval of meeting minutes from June 4, 2026.

Moved by Karen Rankin; seconded by Cindy Archer to approve the minutes from June 4, 2026.

4. Discussion and Updates

4.a. Reports and updates from Park Crew Leader Joseph Lambert and City Staff:

- Picnic table and boulder relocation
- Timberhill pavilion and driveway
- Granite park signs
- Lakeview Park Pier
- Quarry Park plaque installation
- Marina

- Parks Crew Leader Joseph Lambert gave a summary of park crew work over the previous month.
 - Boulder location was clarified.
 - Timberhill driveway can be graveled, but a full road base project is not feasible.
 - The Granite Park signs remain on hold until equipment is available.
 - Updates were provided on the Lakeview Park Pier project.
 - The Quarry Park plaque installation is waiting on large equipment to move stone.
 - There are no funds available in the budget for a marina.

4.b. Discuss and consider the most recent committee brainstorming workshop ideas.

- The committee revisited earlier brainstorming ideas for family activities and park programming, including:
 - Corn hole tournament
 - Pickleball
 - Horseshoes
 - Open mic
 - Movies in the park
 - Paper airplane activity
 - Hot dogs / snacks / park event days

5. Action Items

5.a. Discuss, consider, and take appropriate action to determine final purchases using the 2025-2026 remaining funds.

Ideas to consider:

- Bull horn
 - Horseshoe pits
 - Gift cards for children's contests
 - Corn hole bags & metal containers
 - Supplies to make paper planes
 - Trash Can lids
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- The committee discussed purchasing corn hole bags and storage containers

because rodents had destroyed previous bags.

- Discussion included the cost of 8 sets and the need for a container strong enough to keep out rats

Moved by Karen Rankin; seconded by Tammie Sander to allocate \$200 for the purchase of 8 sets of corn hole bags.

- The committee discussed supplies for paper airplane activities.

- It was clarified that the main supply needed was simply paper, such as plain paper, cardstock, or construction paper.

Moved by Michele Landfield; seconded by Karen rankin to allocate \$50 for paper supplies for paperplane event.

- The committee discussed trash can lids, described as useful for park cleanliness and access.

Moved by Tammie Sander; seconded by Kerry Landfield to allocate \$1,500 for the purchase of 10 trash can lids.

Voting Against: None

- The committee discussed dog waste bag dispensers for trails.

Moved by Karen Rankin; seconded by Kerry Landfield to allocate \$500 for the purchase of 3 of the doggy poop bag dispensers.

Motion Passed: 6 - 0

Voting For: Tammie Sander, Michele Landfield, Karen Rankin, Peter Hutnick, Cindy Archer, Kerry Landfield

Voting Against: None

- Horseshoe pits were discussed extensively.
- No final purchase motion was recorded for the horseshoe pits during this

meeting.

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- Several members expressed the need to get more people into parks through programming and promotion.
 - Ideas included:
 - Advertising park amenities online
 - Occasional small contests
 - A “parks passport” or ticket-punch style activity
 - Events that bring families to multiple parks
